Instead, I am at home online writing this newsletter and listening to the retired pastors tell of stories that moved them during their ministry.

Yes, there were all the normal stories of hearing God's call. And some had even run from the call, but God caught up with them as He always does. They also reminded everyone to stay in tune with God, always relying on His goodness for your life. Then one retiring pastor which I do not recall his name, began to tell of a hospital visit that he had. This visit was to a 97-year-old woman who had fallen and was still trying to recover. This woman had been an active member of the church forever but as age was gaining on her, had slipped out of the picture, if you will. He really did not know what he was going to talk about with her but at this pastoral visit, this man was urged to ask this lady, "Have you ever accepted Jesus Christ into your heart." This life long and active church member - the person that everybody knew answered, "No, I haven't." Well, this pastor took the time to ask the question, and then they prayed. And this woman interrupted and said that someone was knocking on the door and it needed to be answered. There was no one at the door. The pastor explained that it was Jesus knocking at the door of her heart. Awesome story. She died two days later. This pastor asked the most important question of all time in the nick of time.

Think about that. This faithful church goer never sat down and asked Jesus into her heart. You know my first question right. Have you? Have you ever said, "Jesus, here I am, I am yours for the taking. I am a sinner and need you for my salvation." This is your chance to say "Yes."

Second question, do you believe that everyone in your family, your church family, have said "Yes" to Jesus. Just because you know someone knows about Jesus does not mean that they know Jesus. There is only one way to know for sure and that is to ask. Yes, I know I have asked everyone to talk to people in town. Talk to the unchurched. Invite them to worship or bible study. Tell them of your friend Jesus to further the kingdom. But let's not forget the people who **WE** think are saved. We cannot assume that everybody we know is saved. Let's be sure.
