It is planting time; corn, soybeans, watermelon and almost everything else. Looking out the window and realizing this, I thought about "The Parable of the Sower." Matthew 13:3-9

³ Then he told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. ⁴ As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. 5 Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. ⁶ But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. ⁷ Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. 8 Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. 9 Whoever has ears, let them hear."

Not only planting happens this time of year; so does spring cleaning. So does reevaluating how you are doing in life. Now I am not asking you where you have been evangelizing or with who. But I would like you to stop and read this scripture one more time. Only this time ask yourself, which soil are you? When the farmer threw the seed and it landed on you, were you the path? Maybe the rocks or the thorns? Maybe the good soil?

The farmer, aka whoever it was that led you to Jesus, wants the seed in you to bloom and grow - as much as a hundred times!

I think that maybe sometimes we choose the soil we want to be. But we have the option to change that. We can be better soil. Better soil for God, for our church, and for our community.

The best soil produces more of a crop. The best soil tells more people about the good news of Jesus Christ. How do you know if you are good soil? Well, you are reading this. That means you care. That means you want a better life for yourself and the people you know whether they are Christians or not. And if they are not, it is up to us speak up. Speak up with actions and with words.
