



Cullom Stained Glass Window Repair 2024

Cullom United Methodist Church had a square of storm window fall down and break from the outside of the large east stained glass window of the sanctuary. This needed to be replaced and it was noticed from looking from the inside of the window that some repairs needed to be done on the stained glass also. Glass FX came and gave an estimate of what it would cost to do this work. They had done some work on the windows some years ago and proved to be a good reliable company to do the work, They were fully insured and very professional and responsible. They were awarded the job of doing the outside and inside work. First, they replaced the outside storm window. Then they removed a small triangle of stained glass up in the left hand corner and a long section below as shown in the picture. They took these portions back to their business in Champaign, IL and repaired them and brought them back two days later. They look wonderful as you can see from the second picture. We are so thankful to have Glass FX to do such good efficient work on the beautiful windows.

In order to do this work, the piano, organ, benches etc had to be removed out of the choir loft so the workers could get to the windows. The first day of moving the furniture out, Gary Hamilton, Rick Allen and Jared Haberkorn got the job done. Then Gary Hamilton, Jared Haberkorn and Torin Mettille got them moved back. This was all done in the middle of the week and we never had a worship service without all items being in their place!
